The Programme supports the empowerment of vulnerable individuals in the transnistrian region by promoting and protecting their human rights. This goal is achieved by providing information and support to civil society organisations (CSOs) focused on human rights. UNFPA supports adolescents and young people by ensuring access to sexual and reproductive health services, facilitating a safe and healthy transition to adulthood.



TIME PERIOD: **2022 - 2025**

UNFPA BUDGET: **279,403 USD**

UNFPA PROGRAMME TARGET GROUPS:

- Adolescents and young people in the transnistrian region, including those in vulnerable situations;
- Representatives of civil society organisations in the transnistrian region working with adolescents and young people.

UNFPA OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES:

1. Empower civil society organisations in the transnistrian region to help young people understand their rights and make informed decisions about their reproductive health:

Organise training programs for civil society organisations in adolescent and youth reproductive health rights and education;

Create opportunities for learning and experience exchange between CSOs on both banks of the Nistru river.

2. Support CSOs in organizing extracurricular programmes for adolescent and young people's reproductive health education:

Conduct reproductive health education programmes for adolescents and young people aged 10 to 24;

Organize informational activities for parents and other adults about the reproductive health and rights of adolescents and young people.



3. Facilitate access to youth-friendly health services for adolescents in the transnistrian region:

- Train doctors in the transnistrian region to be more youth-friendly and approachable in providing health services;
 - Organize study visits to Youth-Friendly Health Centers on the right bank of the Nistru river to learn about the services they offer;

Refer young people to Youth-Friendly Health Centers.
