Conduct comprehensive education activities on adolescent and young people's reproductive health in non-formal settings:

The Programme supports civil society organisations in developing competencies in sexual and reproductive health by conducting out-of-school outreach activities for adolescents and their families.



Develop and adapt support materials for extracurricular reproductive health education programs for adolescents and young people:

• Guidelines for providing youth-friendly health services for various vulnerable groups, based on the experience of the National Network of Youth-Friendly Health Centers in Moldova;

Digital training programme for comprehensive sexual education facilitators. This will develop the necessary skills and knowledge for facilitating sexual and reproductive health programmes and is aimed at civil society organisations, teachers, psychologists, peer educators, and others interested in these areas;

Educational materials for boys and girls aged 9-12 and 13-15 will complement comprehensive sexual education programmes. These materials will address various questions and concerns specific to these age groups, covering topics related to their sexual and relational health and well-being.
